A Week @ the Museum ***Summer Camp Info Sheet***

The Red Deer Museum + Art Gallery (MAG) is excited to offer your child a chance to spend the week at the museum this summer. Our goal is to provide a fun week where your child will learn new skills, create and use their imagination. Below is some useful information about our summer camps.

When can I drop off and pick up my child?

Drop-off: 8:30 – 9:00 am, Pick up: 4:00 – 4:30 pm

Early drop-off is available from **7:45-8:30 am** and **late pick-up** is available from **4:30-5:15 pm** for an **additional fee**. The additional cost is **\$25/week** for early drop-off OR late pick-up; **\$50/week** for **BOTH** early drop-off AND late pick-up. Single day options are not available. *Do you need early drop off or late pickup for your child and have not registered yet? Give us a call at 403-309-8405.*

***Important note:** Camper pick-up is by 4:30 pm each day of the camp, unless the child has been pre-registered for late pick-up. If your child is not picked up within the timeframe they are registered for, MAG staff reserve the right to contact the Emergency Contact as named on the child's Annual Registration Form to pick up the child. Your account will be flagged with the full late pick-up fee amount (\$25) if the late pick-up service is utilized without prior registration.

What will my child do all day?

Our schedule is as follows:

7:45 – 8:30	Early Drop-off (pre-registration required)
8:30 – 9:00	Standard Drop-off (quiet activities)
9:00 – 9:30	Introductions, rules, ice breakers
9:30 – 12:00	Theme based art or museum activities for each age group (6-8 yrs. and 9-11 yrs.) Mid-morning snack – approx. 10:30 am
12:00 – 12:30	Lunch
12:30 – 2:45	Movement (outdoor activities), games and theme based activities. Mid-afternoon snack/break – approx. 2:45 pm
3:00 – 4:30	Theme based activity/free time in the galleries & standard pick-up
4:30 – 5:15	Late Pick-up (pre-registration required)

*Each week will include time spent at Barret Park, Blue Grass Spray Park and Coronation Park along with cultural walks through downtown Red Deer, Rotary Park and Heritage Square (all within a 10 minute walk of the museum). We recommend that kids come with bathing suits every day.

**There will be four program leaders accompanying the group for each field trip with a first aid kit and all emergency and contact information for each child.

What does my child need to bring?

Children need to bring the following items:

- Food for lunch and 2 snacks (please note, the MAG is **not** a peanut free facility)
- Water bottle
- Appropriate dress for being outside – no matter what the weather (bring a hat)
- Bathing suit and towel for water park
- Any medications that are needed
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Running shoes – for walking and games
- NO ELECTRONICS – keep them at home where they are safe
- Extra set of clothing (art can be messy!)
